The Agora BCN Residence was created by the Gaspar Espuña-CETT Foundation to provide a comprehensive response to CETT students and the wider university community in Barcelona. Opened in June 2006 and located on the Mundet Campus (UB), it forms part of the CETT-UB Campus for Tourism, Hospitality and Gastronomy. Part of its organisation is linked to Hotel Alimara, with which it shares several services.

The residence comprises two interconnected buildings, Llobregat and Besòs, offering 220 rooms, six of which are adapted for people with reduced mobility.

With its high-quality services and facilities, Agora enables residents to focus on academic success, offering a dining hall with a varied and balanced menu, common areas, gym, multipurpose rooms, study and computer rooms, garden, and sports area, among others.
